

## Laurel's Remote Holder

### Supplies

5/8 yard for backing

5/8 yard for top

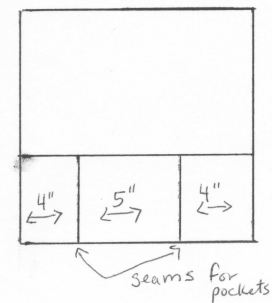
1 - 18" x 30" cotton batting

### Cutting:

From back & top fabrics cut:

1 - 18" x 30" rectangle

1. Place backing fabric right side up, and then layer batting and top fabric wrong side down. Baste with basting spray and pins. Machine quilt a diagonal crosshatch or free motion quilt as desired. (Hint: If using crosshatch, use your seam guide that came with your sewing machine, that way then you only have to make one marking line to start.)
2. Trim remote holder to 13 ½" x 25 ½".
3. Binding: From top or backing fabric cut 3 – 2 ¼" strips. Sew short ends together making 1 continuous strip. Press strip in half wrong sides together. Place binding raw edges even to back of quilt. Stitch by machine. Turn binding to front and machine stitch all the way around.
4. From bottom edge of remote holder fold up 6", pin in place. Sew side edges together, backstitching at top & bottom to reinforce seam.
5. Measure 4" from left edge and sew seam to form a pocket. Measure 5" from seam just sewn and repeat to make 2 more pockets. See diagram.
