

## Pocket Potholder

### Supplies

1/3 yard main fabric

1/3 yard of Insul Bright heat resistant batting

1-fat ¼ of coordinating fabric for bias binding 60"

### Cutting

Cut 3-9" circles from main fabric

Cut one of the three circles in half.

Cut 2-9" circles from Insul Bright batting

From the fat ¼:

Cut 2¾" bias strips to make a 60" strip bias binding.

To make pocket unit:

1. Apply bias binding to straight edge of each ½ circle pieces.
2. With wrong sides together, meet the two Insul Bright circles, with shiny sides facing out. Machine baste outer edge.
3. Sandwich Insul Bright circles between wrong sides of the two outer fabric circles. Place the 2-½" circles from Step 1 right side up. Machine baste unit together.
4. Bind outer edge of the potholder with remaining bias binding.
